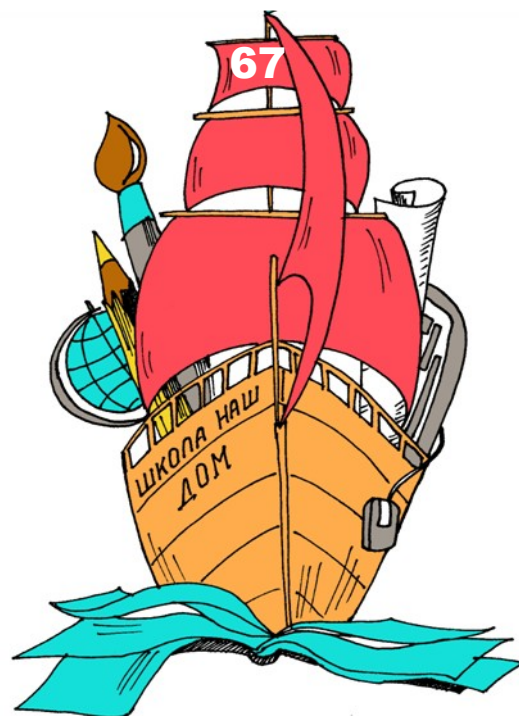
We love our school and are very proud of it!

From the history of our school

We want to tell you about our school. We study at secondary school № 67 of Ordjonikidzevskii district of Yekaterinburg. It is located in Stachek Street, 20. It was built in 1933. This year we celebrate 80th anniversary of our beloved school!

We do know here each step, each wall, and even each corner. My school is the oldest and one of the best schools in our district. We visited our school museum and learned some information about the history of our school. The first directors of the school were Vera Vasilievna Bobrova, Maria Andreevna Milnikova, Rufim Pavlovich Kostilev.



During the Great Patriotic War there was a hospital in the school. In 1942 the pupil of the 2d form Mara Koleva suggested to get money to buy a tank. 180 thousands roubles were got. On the 15th of April, 1943 the "Pupils' Tank" was sent to the front. It was called "Школьник Свердловска".

In 1992 Galina Nikandrovna Arbuzova became a director of the school. She is a director of the school now. She is a real professional. She loves children and does her best for the school!



In 2002 the school was rebuilt. Now it is beautiful!

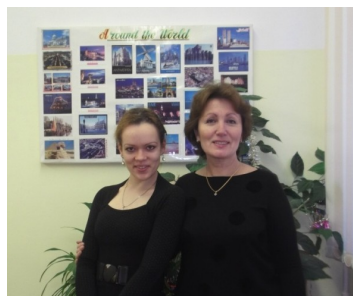
mind, Literature is a very creative subject, which helps us "to learn to dream", for example when we write an essay.

Maria Ivanovna loves to teach us, and we love studying with her!!!

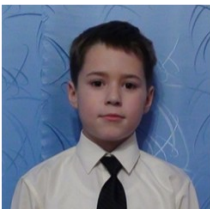
Elena Polovinkina, 5D

I like my school very much. My school is the Best! I wish it all goods.

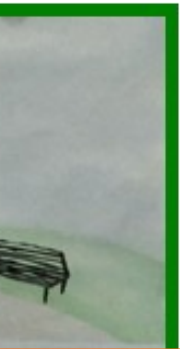

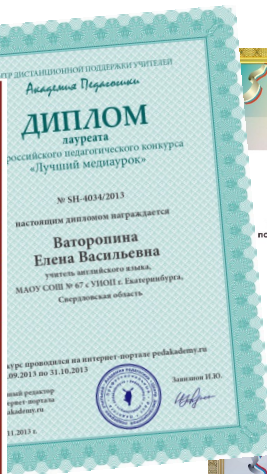

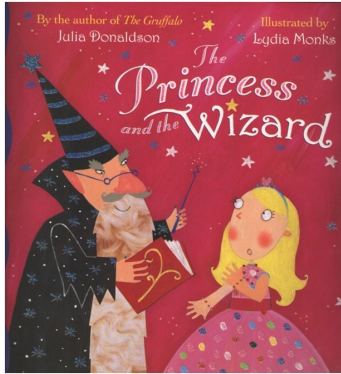

Remy the rat loves to cook. He goes to Paris and finds a famous chef's restaurant. He helps a boy who works in the

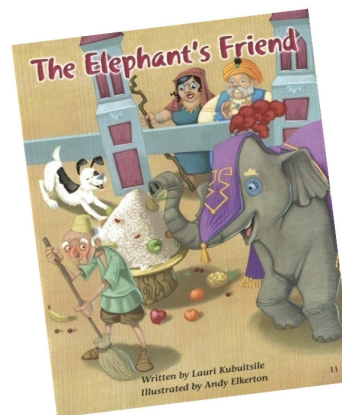
kitchen to make delicious food. Together they cope with difficulties. Remy becomes the chef of the restaurant!
