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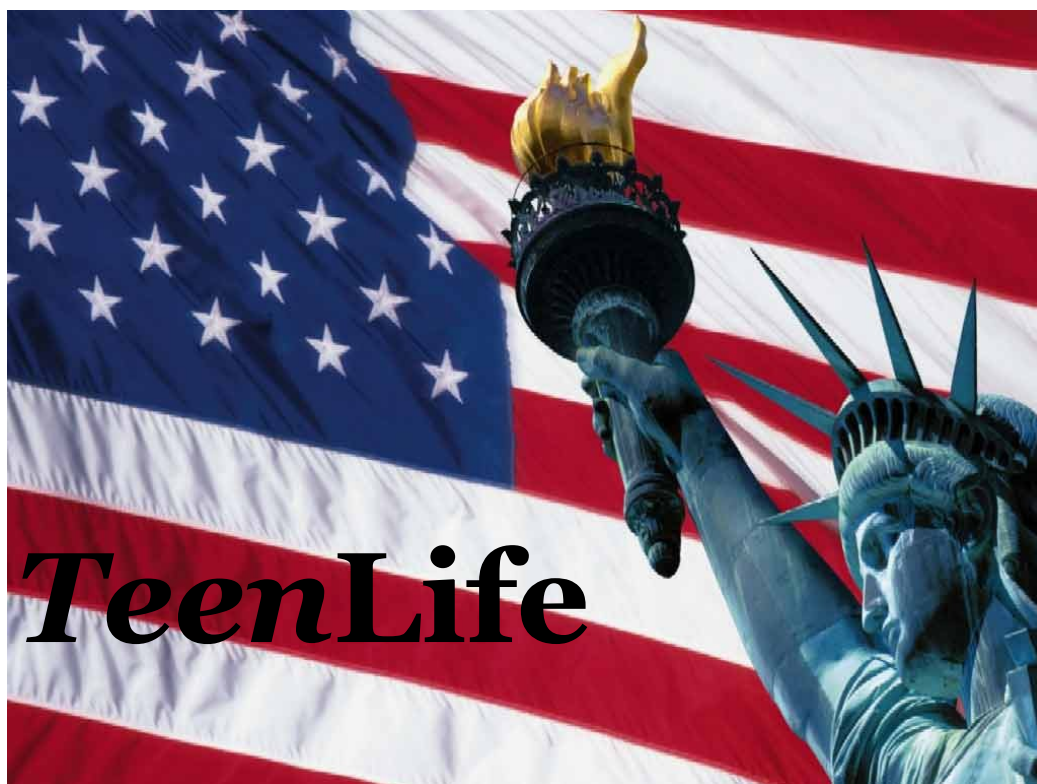

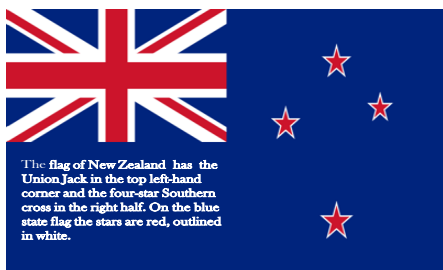
We visited my aunt. I lived there for two months and I went to school. Some

Some words about the country.

Maoris were the first inhabitants of New Zealand,

arriving on the islands in about 1000. Maori oral history maintains that the Maoris came to the island in seven canoes from other parts of Polynesia. The Treaty of Waitangi between the British and several Maori tribes promised to protect Maori land if the Maoris recognized British rule. Encroachment by British settlers was relentless, however, and skirmishes between the two groups intensified. Due to its remoteness, New Zealand was one of the last lands to be settled by humans. During its long isolation New Zealand developed a distinctive fauna dominated by birds, many of which became extinct after the arrival of humans and introduced mammals. With a mild maritime climate, the land was mostly covered in forest. After World War II, New Zealand joined Australia and the United States in the ANZUS security treaty, although the United States later suspended the treaty after New Zealand banned nuclear weapons. New Zealanders enjoyed one of the highest standards of living in the world. The majority of New Zealand's population is of European descent; the indigenous Maori are the larg-

est minority, followed by Asians and non-Maori Polynesians. English, Maori and New Zealand Sign Language are the official languages, with English predominant. Many artists now combine Maori and Western techniques to create unique art forms. The country's culture has also been broadened by globalization and increased immigration from the Pacific Islands and Asia. New Zealand's diverse landscape provides many opportunities for outdoor pursuits and has provided the backdrop for a number of big budget movies.

New Zealand has one of the most amazing landscapes on the planet; primeval forests, endless sandy beaches, snow-capped mountain peaks, bubbling volcanic pools, fast-flowing rivers and glacier-fed lakes. The spectacular landscape, temperate climate and fascinating range of animal and plant life, have made it a paradise for nature lovers from all over the globe. Not many countries have such different landscapes, environments and ecosystems all so close to each other. Whether you're out in the rugged wilderness areas of the natural parks or in some of the perfectly manicured private gardens, you'll find an amazing range of native plants found nowhere else on earth. To my mind, New Zealand is one of the most beautiful places in the world

Why and How to Study English?

(Or the “Work and Travel” Programme)



To know English today is absolutely necessary for every educated person. But everyone understands that it is not easy. There are lots of reasons to study English. Some people need it at work or to communicate with foreigners. Others speak English travelling around the world. It is the language of business, sport and computers.

Students study the English language at schools, colleges and universities. Some of them have the extra studies to improve their English. They visit different courses and private tutors. So did I. Besides school there were five years of studying English at the University. It's quite difficult to be a student of the faculty of foreign languages, but interesting. I'd like to tell you about my experience of speaking English.

When I was a fourth-year student I got to know

about the “Work and Travel” programme, which offered students a chance to go to the USA in summer to work for American companies in a sphere of service and after that to travel around the country. I had a good opportunity to visit the USA, to earn some money, to meet new friends and I tried my chance...

At the beginning of May 2007, I got a visa, a job offer and air tickets from Yekaterinburg to New York. And on the 21st of May my dream came true. It was a long way by plane. I changed a plane in Check Republic and in nine hours I was in J. F. K. International Airport. Then my friend and I took a bus to Lake Placid, NY. It is a little town and we stayed there for 3 months. We lived in a two-storeyed house. There were nine of Russian students in our house. It was pretty funny. I worked as a housekeeper at my first job. I cleaned rooms in a hotel and for a good job I got tips from the guests. And my part time job was in a café like a McDonalds. I like both of the jobs because of my nice employers and communication with people. In general, Americans like Russian students who come to the USA for the summer. They are good hosts and

friends and ready to help. And of course I had weekends and travelled different cities. I liked New York City most of all. I had a lot of pictures when I returned to Russia.

The most fascinating thing in America is communication with native speakers. Everyone who comes to the States has the aim to improve their English, to see how Americans live. During my staying here I was collecting and studying the information about American slang which helped me to write my diploma.

America gave me a significant life experience. I realized who I am and improved my English, but I don't want to live here. I like my country and I wouldn't like to change my life. And I advise everybody to be a participant of the “Work and Travel” programme. It is worth it...

American dream

Мода ездить за границу – распространенное явление XXI века. Франция, Германия, Турция, Египет, Чехия, о. Крит. И это ещё не весь список распространенных мест, где уже точно побывала нога русских туристов. И страна—«мечта», которая сама создала себе этот образ, не осталась без внимания. Практически каждый школьник знает об этой стране и хотел бы туда поехать. Да, это Америка! Страна, в которую мечтают поехать миллионы девушек и юношей, чтобы прогуляться по улицам бегающего Нью-Йорка, выпить капучино в знаменитой кофейне Starbaks, увидеть небоскрёбы, которые так впечатляют нас в американских фильмах. Леманова Юлия Анатольевна уже осуществила эту мечту, и она поделится своими впечатлениями.

К.: Расскажите, где вы были в Америке, какие интересные места посетили, что вам больше всего понравилось?

Ю.А.: Я была в Нью-Йорке, Бостоне, Вашингтоне. Плавала на теплоходе в открытый океан на встречу с китами. Там было прикормленное место, где китов было большое количество. Они выпрыгивали из воды, как дельфины. Экскурсовод была сильно удивлена: в тот день впервые за 40 лет её работы их было так много. И в итоге на прощание один кит проплыл прямо под кораблем.

Какой город больше всего понравился?

Ю.А.: Все города совершенно разные. Нью-Йорк очень светлый город.

Там действительно все «бегают»?

Да, там, действительно, все куда-то мчатся. Особенно, когда попадаешь на Таймс Сквер, понимаешь, что это настоящая суeta, там стоит гул, кто-то кричит, кто-то кого-то толкает, кому-то нужно сфотографироваться. Нью-Йорк – это город высотных зданий. Можно стоять между двумя высотками и видеть лишь маленький кусочек неба.

В Вашингтоне, наоборот, нет высотных зданий. Там изначально было принято решение, что у них не будет зданий выше Капитолия, поэтому у них нет небоскрёбов. В Вашингтоне много афроамериканцев. Но, например, в Нью-Йорке они совсем другие: им платят большие пособия, они могут не работать, им оплачивают жилье, и поэтому они отличаются от афроамериканцев Вашингтона. В Вашингтоне чернокожие – ин-

теллигентные, образованные, все в строгих костюмах. В Нью-Йорке – бесцеремонные и грубые, что весьма раздражало. А вот в Бостоне я была всего два часа, но очень бросилось в глаза, что это – город белых. Там очень мало людей со смуглой кожей.

Какое место вам больше всего запомнилось?

Ю.А.: По Нью-Йорку я много гуляла. Конечно же, очень впечатляет статуя свободы. А в том месте, где были башни-близнецы, сейчас огромная стройка, но когда там стоишь, в душе что-то переворачивается, когда понимаешь, что именно там случилась эта трагедия. Когда-то перед башнями стояла металлическая сфера. Когда башни рухнули, она оказалась под руинами. А когда завалы раскопали, сферу не стали восстанавливать, а как она была, обуглившаяся и со всеми вмятинами, поставили недалеко от места, где упали башни-близнецы. Там сейчас горит вечный огонь.

Какой уклад жизни у американцев? Что едят? Как отдыхают? Какие взаимоотношения между людьми? Заметили это?

Да, я очень старалась это заметить. Во-первых, это страна, в которой много внимания уделяется удобству: нескользкие ступеньки, салфеточки в туалете. Туалеты у них везде бесплатные. Они уделяют внимание казалось бы мелочам, но с этими мелочами удобно жить, чего не скажешь о нашей стране. Отдыхают они, как в нашей стране: на природе, в кино. Что касается еды, то едят они много – культ еды американцев известен всем.

Говорят, что они очень любят есть гамбургеры, это так?

Нет, как раз таки гамбургеры едят мало, Макдональдсы там почти всегда пусты. Fast food они рассматривают в последнюю очередь. У них популярна китайская, итальянская и японская еда. Особенно небольшие рестораны. Они дешёвые, и в них можно вкусно поесть. Порции дают огромные. В Америке везде принято платить чаевые – в ресторане, в салоне красоты, у зубного врача...

Американцы ведь очень уважают закон?

Скорее, они боятся его. Боятся нарушить и получить штраф

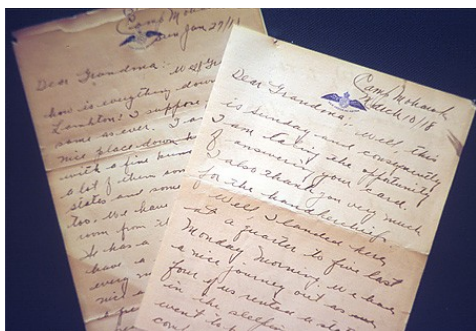
The most important thing is to learn as many English words and grammar rules as it possible. In the result you will learn how to *use* words and grammar. Then, and it is very important, you

I try to discuss different points of view, ask various questions, etc. The next day I choose the other theme for discussion and do the same. In my opinion, this exercise is very effective. I'd like to add, that it is very useful to listen to the songs of the British and American singers and musical groups. At first you should listen to songs with a slow rhythm like "Belladonna", "I have a dream", "Love me do". Then you should to increase the tempo of songs. In a half of the year you will be able to speak English fluently.

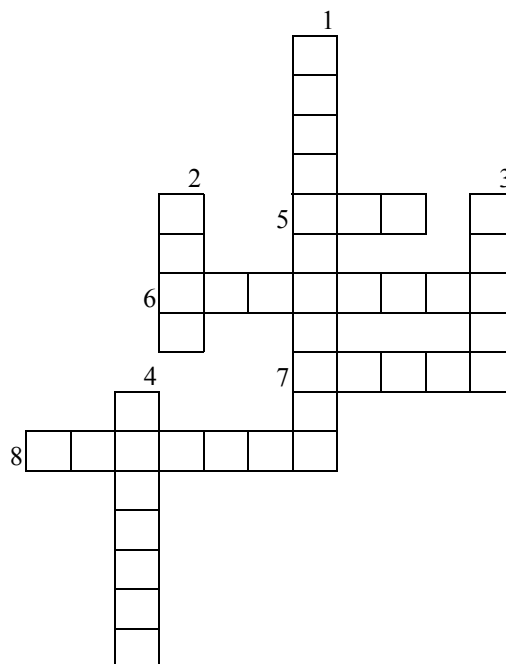
