I hope that my experience was interesting for you and after that you will have new power for working harder to finish school successfully and have a very interesting life! School is really important - don't forget about it!



Fire Show

I'm sure most of us have seen people dancing with fire on beaches, streets, squares. Really beautiful, isn't it? But, unfortunately, practically nobody knows what it is. Let me acquaint you with it.



This direction of culture is called "fire show". If you imagine it you'll agree that it's one of the most impressive things. Before description of its history and technique I'd like to tell you about it as a unique subculture and its sense.

I've been learning it for 3-4 years already. My first meeting with fire show was when my friend showed me some movements... I was so impressed that started to learn it myself. From other sight it seems to be only movements with stuff... But it's not right. Fire is a wild element. It's not easy to subdue it, as a minimum – it's dangerous. But after years of trainings you can be sure you'll do it. It's not a competition, not a kind sport... Fire show is a dance. Dance with wild nature, elements, your spirit. You're alone with fire. It's unforgettable. Now I can't live without it, fire is a part of me and I'm not going to stop practice.

What is a technical part of fire show?

Before making the whole dance you should think on all necessary things: music, image, topic (especially with group-performance). Everything is important. For example, music has one of the most significant role. If you choose something with ethnical character fire show has an ethnical topic: corresponding atmosphere is needed. And if your choice is drum-n-base or drum-step, it'll be a modern dance, modern

costume, neon-light...

Fire show demands a strong body and hands and adroitness. You should start learning it with basic movements of chosen stuff. All other difficult movements are founded on this base. It needs long trainings and a lot of patience. The first time you feel difficultness, but later it becomes easier and easier.

Fire show includes not only movements with stuff, but such a thing like breezes. This action is either called "spit with fire". It's very dangerous for skin on face, but looks wonderful. As for me, the main problem is not to swallow a fuel... Breezes help to feel yourself like a dragon!

But if you want to add some modern things to fire show – diode-stuff is for you. All kinds of requisite is already made with a neon-light. Stroboscope is very popular technical adding. It allows to enjoy not only with fire-light, but with all colors you want in different combinations. As for me, more often I use my Diode-ponies, especially when I'm alone: in case of catching fire on clothes it's difficult to help yourself...



Choosing a profession



The problem of choosing a profession is very important. Choosing a career and getting a job are two of the most important things any person has in his life. Before young people finish school all of them think that they will choose a profession they want. But later all of them understand that choosing a profession or a career is a very serious problem. So when young people leave school, they face that problem.

We held a survey of senior pupils. The questions were the following:

1. Have you chosen your future profession?
2. What kind of profession have you chosen?
3. Where have you learned about your future profession?
4. What characteristics does your future profession possess?
5. Whose opinion is important for you in choosing a career?
6. What professions are the most popular in our country?

According to the results of the questionnaire, a lot of girls have chosen their future profession. Only 12% of them can't say what they want to do in future. They can't choose no one of the professions. About 45% of girls find this question hard to answer.

The most popular among the girls are professions of a doctor and a lawyer. The next one is a manager. About 39% of girls have their own opinion in that question. The least popular answer is a profession of a scientist (about 3%). About 40% of girls have learned about their future profession from TV programs and books. Only 5% have learnt about it from the internet. I think it is very good because, it means that books are more popular than the internet.

The most popular characteristics in future profession for girls are underemployment and flexibility. Modern girls want to be independent and successful. High salary, safety and extreme conditions are not very important for them.

For the biggest part of girls, opinion of their friends is the most important. The next are the representatives of the professions. Only for 5% of girls opinion of their parents is significant when they choose a career.


About 40% of girls consider professions of an actor (an actress) and a soldier the most popular ones. The next one is a doctor. As for me, profession of a doctor is the most popular in our country nowadays. The least popular professions for girls are an engineer, a sportsman, a work-

er, an astronaut and an interpreter. Only about 5% of girls think that a scientist and a politician are the most demanded professions in our country.

Boys and girls have very different points of view.

About 50% of boys have chosen their future profession. And only 20% find this question hard to answer. I think it is good because the biggest part of boys know what they want to be in future. It is important for their future education. About 30% of boys want to become engineers, 15% want to be soldiers. And about 13% want to be interpreters. The other part of boys wants to become businessmen, workers, lawyers, managers, etc. About 42% of boys have learned about their future profession from friends. About 45% have known about it from the internet

and TV. And only about 15% have learnt about it from their parents.

The most important characteristics of the future profession for boys are career, flexibility, safety and opportunity to travel abroad. Extreme conditions and creative work are important only for about 10% of boys. Other boys want to have underemployment and ability to communicate with people like the main characteristics of their future professions.

For about 43% of boys the opinion of their parents is significant when they choose a career. Opinion of the teacher is important for 25% of boys. The others listen to their friends. About 40% of boys think that professions of a sportsman and a businessman are the most popular in our country. The next ones are a lawyer, a manager and an engineer. Only about 10% of boys think that professions of an astronaut and a soldier are very popular in our country now.


